MacFarland Middle School students are poised to learn. This DC public school has hard-working teachers, enthusiastic coaches, and energetic students. Unfortunately, they lack one key resource essential for learning: a school library.

MacFarland has one dusty room devoted to reading. Its metallic shelves are only partially filled and hold mostly high-school level books published before 1990. An inadequate, out-of-date library hinders learning at any school, but is a major impediment at MacFarland, where only 8% of students last year scored proficient in reading. MacFarland students need access to quality, level-appropriate books to help them regain their footing.

For 4 years, LAYC's AmeriCorps program has helped MacFarland students succeed academically by serving as in-class tutors and providing afterschool clubs and homework assistance. We will continue to provide those services. But we need your help.

The MacFarland Book Drive has a lofty goal: get 1,000 books before the end of February. To reach this goal, we need the support of every friend, family, community member, and organization that cares about helping youth succeed.
